Workers' Comp Symposium Set For Sept. 24

The Insurance Council of Texas (ICT) will hold its first annual workers' compensation symposium in Austin on Wednesday, September 24. Texas Insurance Commissioner Jose Montemayor will offer a state of the Texas workers compensation system at the daylong event.

Montemayor's morning address will be followed by a legislative update presented by ICT general counsel Richard Geiger. Robert Graves of Burns, Anderson, Jury and Brenner will give a regulatory update and Kevin McGillicuddy of Parker & Associates will speak on judicial decisions impacting the Texas workers' compensation system.

The symposium's afternoon session will offer updates on appeals panel decisions and medical benefits. The workers' compensation symposium will conclude with a panel discussion that includes St. Rep. Burt Solomons (R-Carrollton), Richard Levy, Legal Director of the Texas AFL-CIO, Richard Evans, VP of governmental affairs at the Texas Association of Business, Lee Ann Alexander, VP of public affairs and legislative counsel at Liberty Mutual Insurance Co. and Michael Cushman, director of the Department of Health Care Delivery at the Texas Medical Association.

Registration and a continental breakfast for the symposium begin at 7:30 a.m. at the Doubletree Hotel, 6505 North IH 35, in Austin.
