**Membership provides each company the opportunity to play an active role in determining Texas' insurance regulatory policies.**

As members of ICT, insurers can collectively represent their interests in the regulatory process, promote the interests of the Texas property and casualty industry, and stay up to date on events, legislation, and trends affecting the business of insurance in Texas.

ICT advocates and educates on behalf of its members in public hearings and in meetings with the staff of the Texas Department of Insurance and the Division of Workers' Compensation. ICT monitors TDI hearings and, when appropriate, provides testimony or comments on behalf of its members.

**ICT monitors the Texas legislature for all property and casualty bills, and follows those bills through the legislative process, reporting back to member companies on how potential laws may affect their interests.**
